Exodus 24

1 To Moshe [Adonai] said, “Come up to Adonai — you, Aharon, Nadav, Avihu, and seventy of the leaders of Isra’el. Prostrate yourselves at a distance, 2 while Moshe alone approaches Adonai — the others are not to approach, and the people are not to go up with him.” 3 Moshe came and told the people **EVERYTHING**

Adonai had said, **INCLUDING ALL THE RULINGS**. The people answered with one voice: “We will obey every word Adonai has spoken.” 4 Moshe wrote down **ALL** the words of Adonai.

The Word of God

Exodus 34

27 Adonai **SAID** to Moshe, “Write these **WORDS** down, because they are the terms of the covenant I have made with you and with Isra’el.” 28 Moshe was there with Adonai forty days and forty nights, during which time he neither ate food nor drank water. [Adonai] wrote on the tablets the **WORDS** of the covenant, the Ten **WORDS**.

To speak, declare, organize a matter using words



The Word of God

Definition

- Hebrew **תּוֹרָה** = **Torah**: instruction, doctrine, teaching, guidance, principles, law
- Greek **νόμος** = **Nomos**: law, custom, rule, or principle



Root word of Torah: יָרַה = Yarah

- Literally: “to shoot an arrow” (straight, to a target), implying targeted direction/hitting the mark
- Figuratively: to show, to direct, to instruct

Leviticus 11

45 For I am Adonai, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt to be your God. Therefore, **YOU ARE TO BE HOLY, BECAUSE I AM HOLY.**

Leviticus 19

1 Adonai said to Moshe, 2 “Speak to the entire community of Isra’el; tell them, ‘You people **ARE TO BE HOLY BECAUSE I, ADONAI YOUR GOD, AM HOLY.**

7 Therefore consecrate yourselves — you people **MUST BE HOLY, BECAUSE I AM ADONAI YOUR GOD.**

Tractate Sotah 14a

Just as [God] clothes the naked [Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden] . . . so too you should clothe the naked. Just as [God] visits the sick [Abraham after his circumcision] . . . so too should you visit the sick. Just as God consoles mourners [Isaac after the death of his father, Abraham] . . . so too you should console mourners. Just as God buried the dead [Moses, toward the very end of the Torah] . . . so too should you bury the dead



The Word of God

Deuteronomy 31

9 Then Moshe **WROTE DOWN THIS TORAH** and gave it to the Cohanim, the descendants of Levi who carried the ark with the covenant of Adonai, and to all the leaders of Isra'el. 10 Moshe gave them these orders: "At the end of every seven years, during the festival of Sukkot in the year of sh'mittah, 11 when all Isra'el have come to appear in the presence of Adonai at the place he will choose, you are to **READ THIS TORAH** before all Isra'el, **SO THAT THEY CAN HEAR IT.**



The Word of God

Deuteronomy 31

12 Assemble the people — the men, the women, the little ones and the foreigners you have in your towns — so that they can **HEAR, LEARN, FEAR ADONAI YOUR GOD** and take care to **OBEY ALL THE WORDS OF THIS TORAH**; 13 and so that their children, who have not known, **CAN HEAR AND LEARN TO FEAR ADONAI YOUR GOD**, for as long as you live in the land you are crossing the Yarden to possess.”



The Word of God

Isaiah 40

6 A voice says, “Proclaim!”

And I answer, “What should I proclaim?”

“All humanity is merely grass,

all its kindness like wildflowers:

7 the grass dries up, the flower fades,
when a wind from Adonai blows on it.

Surely the people are grass!

8 The grass dries up, the flower fades;

**BUT THE WORD OF OUR GOD WILL STAND
FOREVER.”**

James 1

12 How blessed is the man who perseveres through temptation! For after he has passed the test, he will receive as his crown the Life which God has promised **TO THOSE WHO LOVE HIM**. 13 No one being tempted should say, “I am being tempted by God.” For God cannot be tempted by evil, and God himself tempts no one. 14 Rather, each person is being tempted whenever he is being dragged off and enticed by the bait of his own desire. 15 Then, having conceived, the desire gives birth to sin; and when sin is fully grown, it gives birth to death. 16 Don’t delude yourselves, my dear brothers.

receive meekly **THE WORD IMPLANTED** in you that can
save your lives.



The Word of God

James 1

22 Don't deceive yourselves by **ONLY HEARING WHAT
THE WORD SAYS BUT DO IT!**

23 For whoever **HEARS THE WORD BUT DOESN'T DO
WHAT IT SAYS** is like someone who looks **AT HIS FACE
IN A MIRROR**, 24 who **LOOKS AT HIMSELF**, goes away
and immediately forgets what he looks like.



The Word of God

James 1

25 But if a person **LOOKS CLOSELY INTO THE PERFECT TORAH, WHICH GIVES FREEDOM, AND CONTINUES, BECOMING NOT A FORGETFUL HEARER BUT A DOER OF THE WORK IT REQUIRES**, then he will be blessed in what he does. 26 Anyone who thinks he is religiously observant **BUT DOES NOT CONTROL HIS TONGUE** is deceiving himself, and his observance counts for nothing.

16 In the same way, let your light shine before

Matthew 5

17 “DON’T THINK that I have come TO ABOLISH THE TORAH OR THE PROPHETS. I have come not to abolish BUT TO COMPLETE.

Πληρόω – plēroō

to make replete, to cram (a net), to furnish, satisfy, execute (an office), verify, accomplish, complete, fulfil, fully preach, perfect, supply

Καταλύω – kataluō

to dislodge, disintegrate, to disintegrate, to halt, specifically to halt the night, destroy, dissolve, come to nought, overthrow

Matthew 5

18 Yes indeed! I tell you that until heaven and earth pass away, **NOT SO MUCH AS A YUD OR A STROKE WILL PASS FROM THE TORAH** — not until everything that must happen has happened.



Torah – The Foundation of Who We Are

Matthew 5

19 So whoever **DISOBEYS THE LEAST OF THESE
MITZVOT AND TEACHES OTHERS TO DO SO**

will be called the least in the Kingdom of Heaven.

But **WHOEVER OBEYS THEM AND SO TEACHES**

will be called great in the Kingdom of Heaven.

17 “Don’t think that I have come to **ABOLISH** the Torah or the Prophets.

19 So whoever **DISOBEYS** the least of these mitzvot and teaches others to do so will be called the least in the Kingdom of Heaven.



Torah – The Foundation of Who We Are

17 I have come not to abolish but to **COMPLETE**.

19 But whoever **OBEYS** them and so teaches will be called great in the Kingdom of Heaven.



Torah – The Foundation of Who We Are

Matthew 5

18 Yes indeed! I tell you that until heaven and earth pass away, not so much as a **YUD** or a **STROKE** will pass from the Torah — not until everything that must happen has happened.

17 **thus anyone who belongs to God may be FULLY EQUIPPED FOR EVERY GOOD WORK.**

Every good work	πᾶς ἀγαθός ἔργον – pas agathos ergon	All good labor (occupation)

Jeremiah 31

30 (31) “Here, the days are coming,” says Adonai, “when I will make a new covenant with the house of Isra’el and with the house of Y’hudah. 31 (32) It will not be like the covenant I made with their fathers on the day I took them by their hand and brought them out of the land of Egypt; because they, for their part, violated my covenant, even though I, for my part, was a husband to them,” says Adonai.

Jeremiah 31

32 (33) “For this is the covenant I will make with the house of Isra’el after those days,” says Adonai: “**I WILL PUT MY TORAH WITHIN THEM AND WRITE IT ON THEIR HEARTS;** I will be their God, and they will be my people.

33 (34) No longer will any of them teach his fellow community member or his brother, ‘Know Adonai’; for **all will know me**, from the least of them to the greatest; because I will forgive their wickednesses and remember their sins no more.”

Ezekiel 36

26 I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit inside you; I will take the stony heart out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. 27 I will put **MY SPIRIT INSIDE YOU AND CAUSE YOU TO LIVE BY MY LAWS, RESPECT MY RULINGS AND OBEY THEM.**
