Shavuot



- Celebrates the harvest of the land God placed His Name on and provided to the nation of Israel
- Establishes the end of the spring barley harvest and the beginning of the great summer wheat harvest
- Bring an offering of praise to God with the first fruits of the harvest, including an offering of two loaves of leavened bread
- Bring a purification offering to cleanse you and free you to draw closer to the Lord

Shavuot



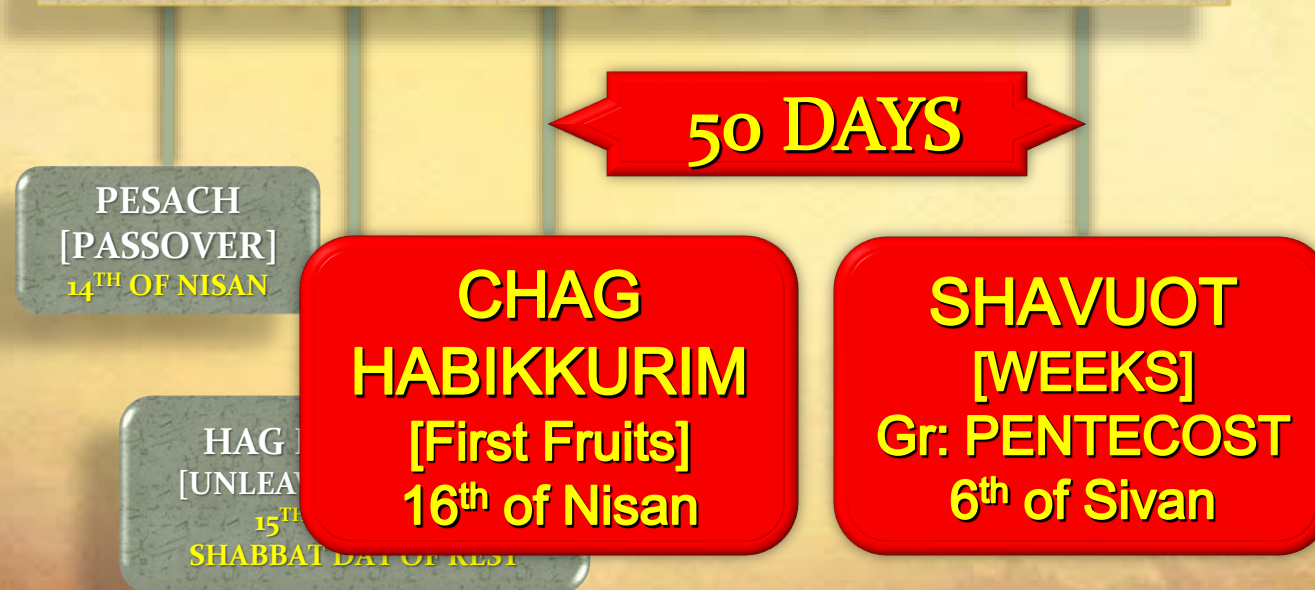
- Bring an offering of fire (Olah) in surrender to the God of creation – the source of all blessings
- Commanded to allow the poor and needy to eat of the four corners of your land throughout the harvest
- It is a Sabbath for everyone in the land
- Commanded again to memorialize the redemption out of slavery in Egypt

Shavuot

Proclaim to the children of Israel – slave or free, rich or poor, widow or orphan – that they are free to partake in the great summer wheat harvest, with the foreigners invited as well.

While we pause to remember yearly Whose land it is, Who provides the nutrients and water for the crops to grow, Who brings life to the land and ensures the harvest...and Who is our covering, our nurturer, our provider.



Shavuot & Yovel

Shavuot reminds us that we till and harvest the land which belongs to God; and He provides everything necessary for the harvest.

The land belongs to Me. Like Eden, I have invited you to live in the land and be my people.

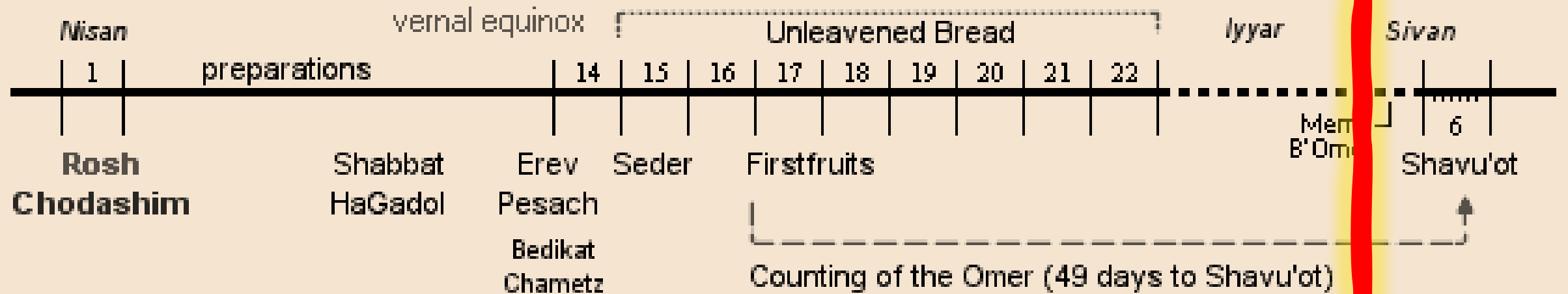
I choose to proclaim freedom at the end of a generation and return you to your ancestral land and your ancestral family.

I will free you from all debts.

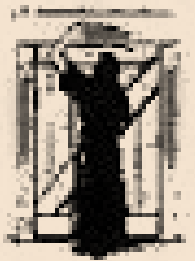

Giving of The Torah

Exodus 19

18 Mount Sinai was enveloped in smoke, because **ADONAI DESCENDED ONTO IT IN FIRE** — its smoke went up like the smoke from a furnace, and the whole mountain **SHOOK VIOLENTLY**. 19 As the sound of the shofar grew louder and louder, Moshe spoke; and God answered him with a voice.

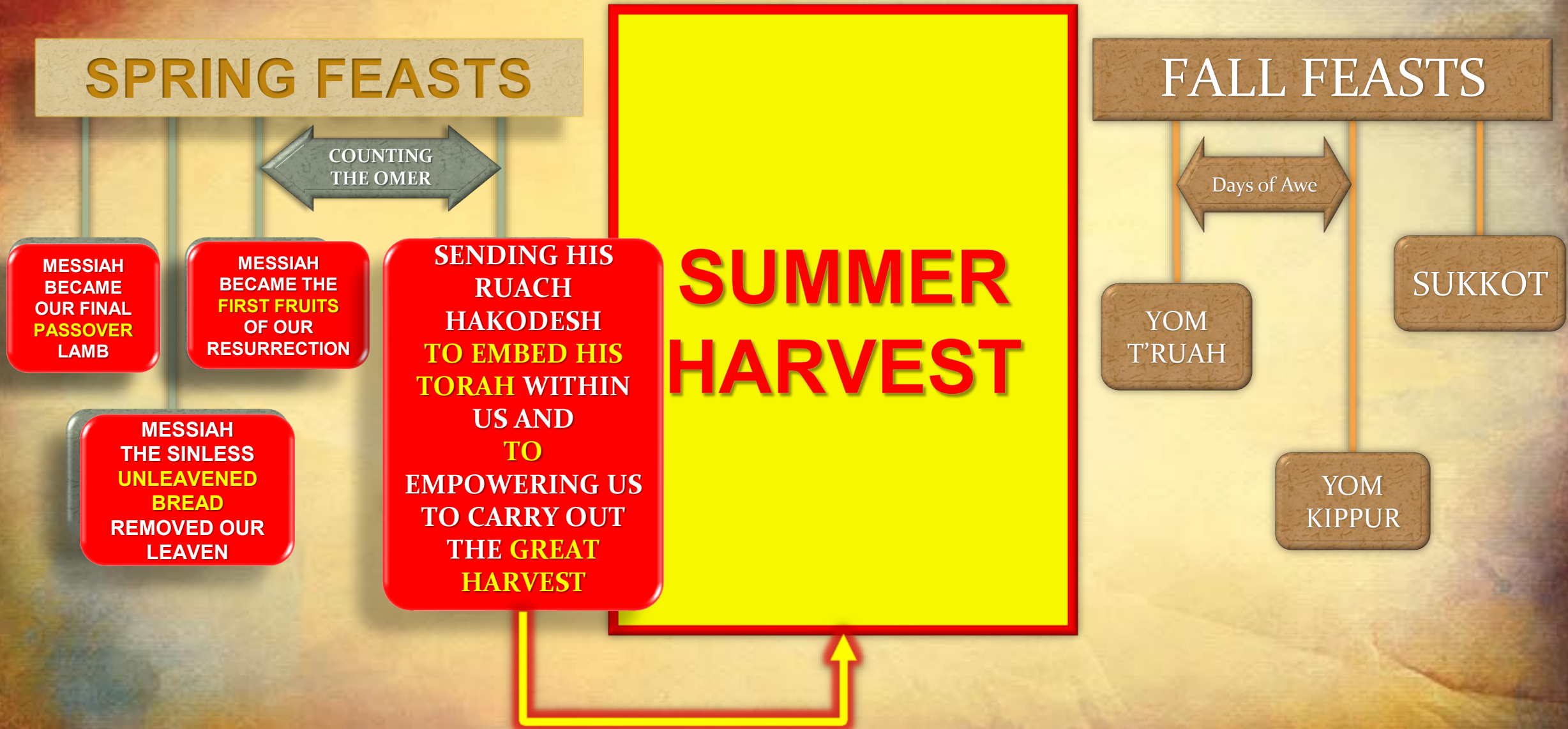

Acts 10
